





(1) QUESTIONS ABOUT LOGGING INTO NRPA'S WEBSITE?

Please click on 'Forgot username?' to validate your Username – you will be required to supply your email address. If that address exists in our database, this will send your Username to that email address and will return you to the Sign In page, where you may need to use the 'Forgot Password?' link.

- > Submissions accepted starting January 6
- > Submissions due Friday, March 24
- Committee reviews April-May
- ► Committee meets in May
- ► Winners announced in June
- Best in Innovation winner revealed at 2023 NRPA Annual Conference in Dallas
